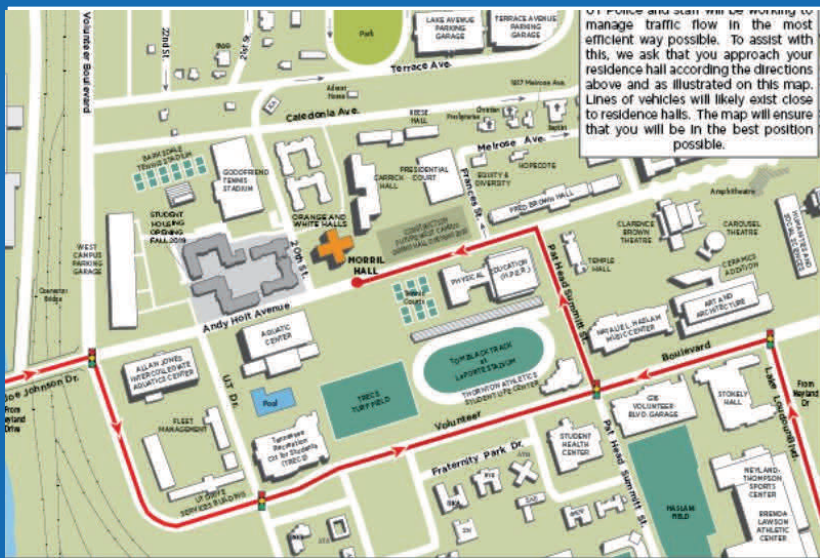

***Thursday, August 16*** Upper-division students and first-year residents participating in the second session of Ignite Leadership Summit will move in from 9:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m.

***Friday, August 17:*** Students will move into their assigned living and learning communities from 10:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. Andy Holt Avenue will be westbound-only from Pat Head Summitt Street to Volunteer Boulevard.

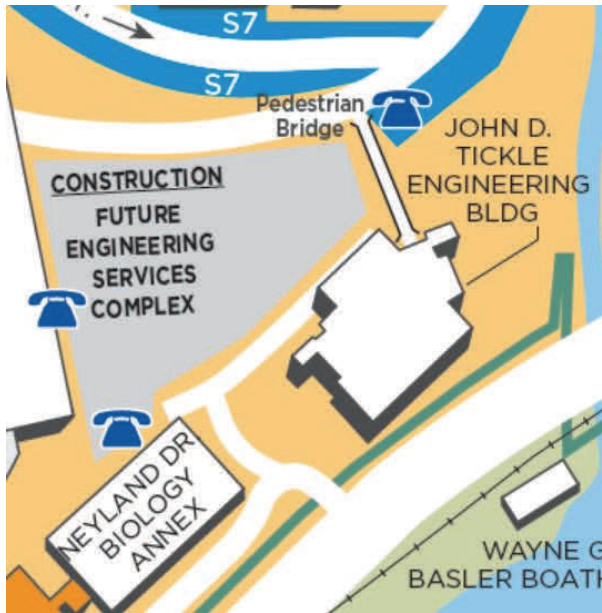
