Selected parking areas convert from daytime parking to special event parking (specifically near Thompson-Boling Arena)

- ◆ Lots usually convert at 4pm Mon-Fri and 4 hours prior to the event on the weekends
- ◆ Commuter and Staff permits will NOT be honored in those areas if you arrive after 4pm Mon-Fri
- ◆ For those attending class or teaching class, alternative Commuter and Staff parking areas for those with a valid permit will be - S9 at the Student Union (Mon-Thu), S23 at Music, and the parking areas on the North side of campus
- ◆ \$20 Special Event parking fee (cash or credit card) begins when the lots open for event parking

## What is this program?

An alternative to paying for citations while helping UT Knoxville students, staff and faculty who don't have a stable food supply.

## Partner:

The initiative is being supported by Student Government Association (SGA) who advocated for this program and a group of students leaders will assist in the communication and outreach efforts.

**Beneficiaries:** Big Orange Pantry and Smokey's Pantry

## Which Tickets Can This Apply To?

Donations for Citations has two types of tickets that are eligible:

- No Permit
- Unauthorized Area

## How Often Can I Use This?

Once per fiscal year (effective July 1 – June 30) for qualifying tickets that individually amount to a \$32.00 maximum.

## Who Can Use This Program?

Eligible participants would be active students, faculty and staff listed in official UT Knoxville records (IRIS & Banner).

## What Do I Donate?

You will donate 5 (five) full-sized, non-perishable items such as food or personal care items
