The T **Access** is a demand response service available to students with an Access ID card issued by UT Student Disability Services. Faculty or staff need to visit the Office of Equity and Diversity to get their **Access** ID card. The T **Access** operates on-demand, point-topoint service on UT's main

campus, Ag Campus, or UT facilities in the Fort Sanders neighborhood, weekdays from 7 am until 6 pm. After 6 pm, persons with disabilities may use the T **Link** service.

NIGHTLY

6PM**-7**AM

The T **Link** operates nightly between 6 pm and 7 am. No disability ID is required. The T **Link** transports students at night to the T Late Nite or to

their destination.


After 6 pm, request pickup through the UT mobile app's transit icon, by campus Blue Phone, or call 865-974-4080.


