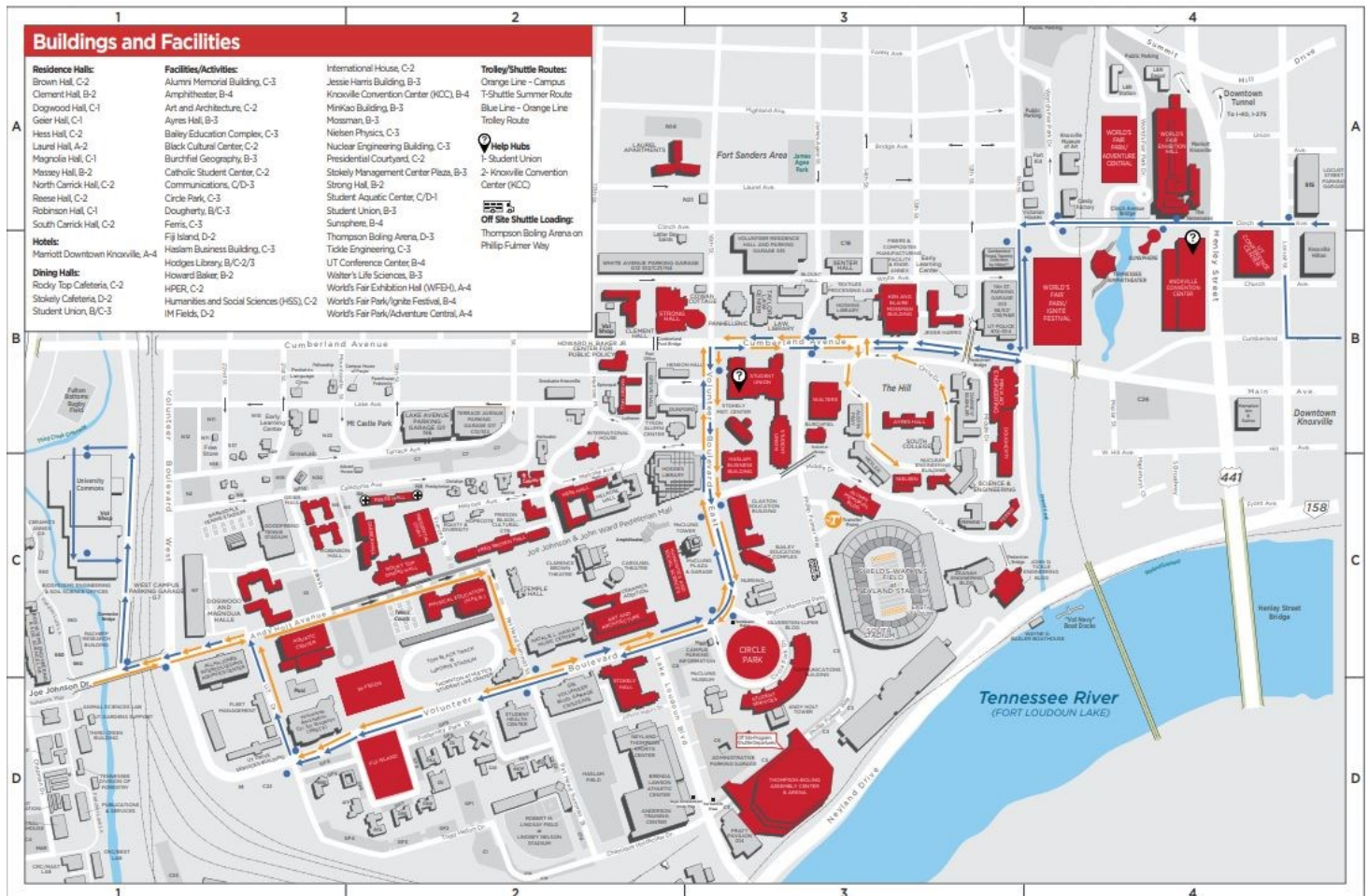
Here are pointers:

- Melrose Ave—one lane closed for bus loading at Massey Hall on Mon, Jul 25 and again on Sat, Jul 30

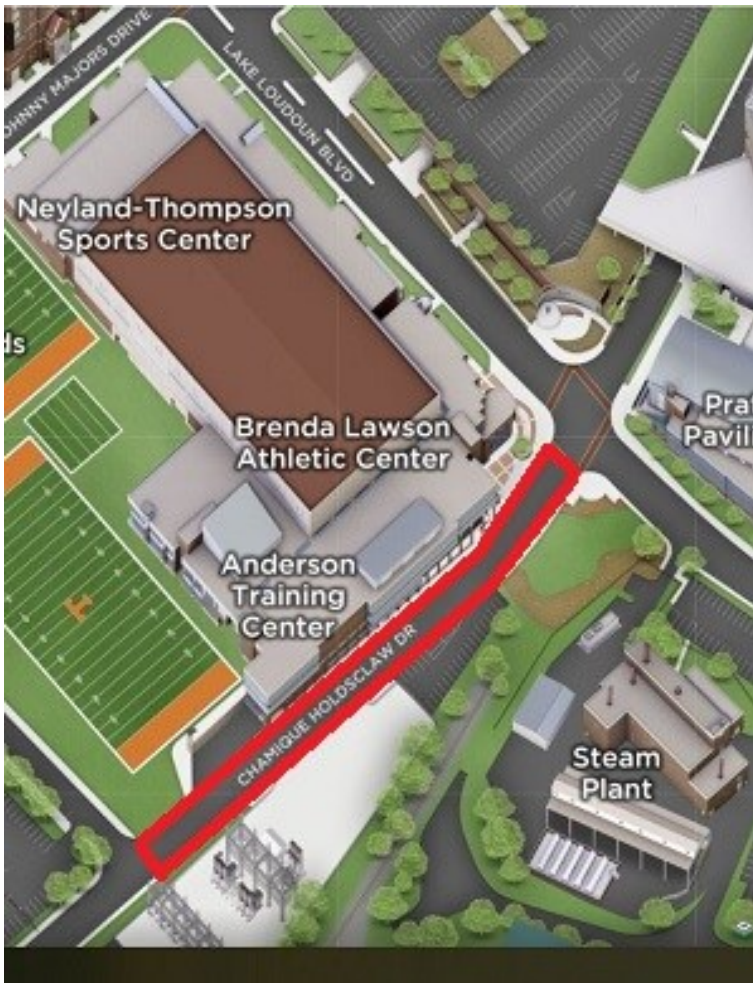
McClung Museum Annual Closure for maintenance - starting Tue, Jul 26 and reopening Wed, Aug 10

- Please note that C8 parking lot will be used as primary parking on Aug 3rd

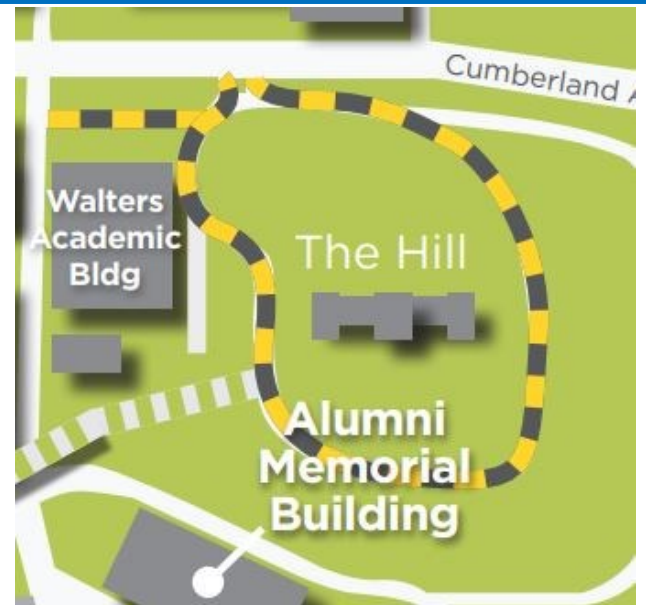




Construction and Paving Updates
