Construction crews are scheduled to mobilize for a combined Century II water and wastewater collection system upgrade project along sections of Clinch Avenue and James Agee Street (see map at right) between late March and July 2023. Below is a step-by-step sequence of events that customers can expect related to wastewater construction in your area:

- 1. Pre-construction markings KUB or its contractor will identify the area where construction will occur with white paint.
- 2. Marking buried utility lines A utility locating contractor will arrive in the area within three business days to locate and mark other buried utilities with colored spray paint or flags.
- 3. Pre-construction CCTV inspection Robotic closed-circuit TV (CCTV) cameras will be installed in manholes to inspect existing wastewater pipes and connections prior to the start of construction.
- 4. Parking/Traffic Impacts Curbside street parking will be restricted in the immediate area where crews are working. Some work associated with this project will also require lane and/or road closures. At least one lane of traffic will remain open where possible. Access to driveways will be maintained.
- **5. Construction** This project will follow the existing water and wastewater system pipelines and manholes in the area shown in red on the attached map.
- 6. Water usage Water service interruptions may be needed to connection customer service lines to the new main. Additionally, you may be asked to limit water usage to minimize wastewater flows.
- Lawn/street restoration KUB's third-party landscaping and paving contractors will complete restoration once construction is complete.
