Prep for First Home Football Game**

Thursday, September 7:

- ◆ 5:00 pm - RV arrivals on Stephenson Dr begin
- ◆ 7:00 pm - Women's Soccer vs Radford at Regal Soccer Stadium

Friday, September 8:

- ◆ 12:00 pm - Ag Campus RVs start arriving at Kingston Pike Bldg
- ◆ 6:00 pm - Ag Campus RVs move from KPB to Ag campus (Staff & Commuter spaces behind Vet Hospital)
- ◆ 8:00 pm Staff & Commuter lots must be clear
- ◆ **UT Departmental Vehicles** must be removed from areas designated for football parking by 8:00 pm (Park at outer edges of Middlebrook Pike facility if you have to move from main campus)

Saturday, September 9:

- ◆ Towing may start as early as 3:00 am in designated football donor parking areas
- ◆ Limited availability—first-come, first-parked, staff required to work, with a valid permit, may park at the S12 lot at Lake Ave or on-street parking on Volunteer Blvd West

PUBLIC PARKING OPTIONS

ON CAMPUS - NONE

OFF CAMPUS

Free to \$40 - City of Knoxville Public Parking Garages and Surface lots

\$15 - Tyson Park - use the Concord St entrance and exit

\$15-\$40 - East TN Children's Hospital - depending on proximity and Non-SEC or SEC game

\$40 - University Commons (between main and Ag Campus by Publix and Fieldhouse Social)

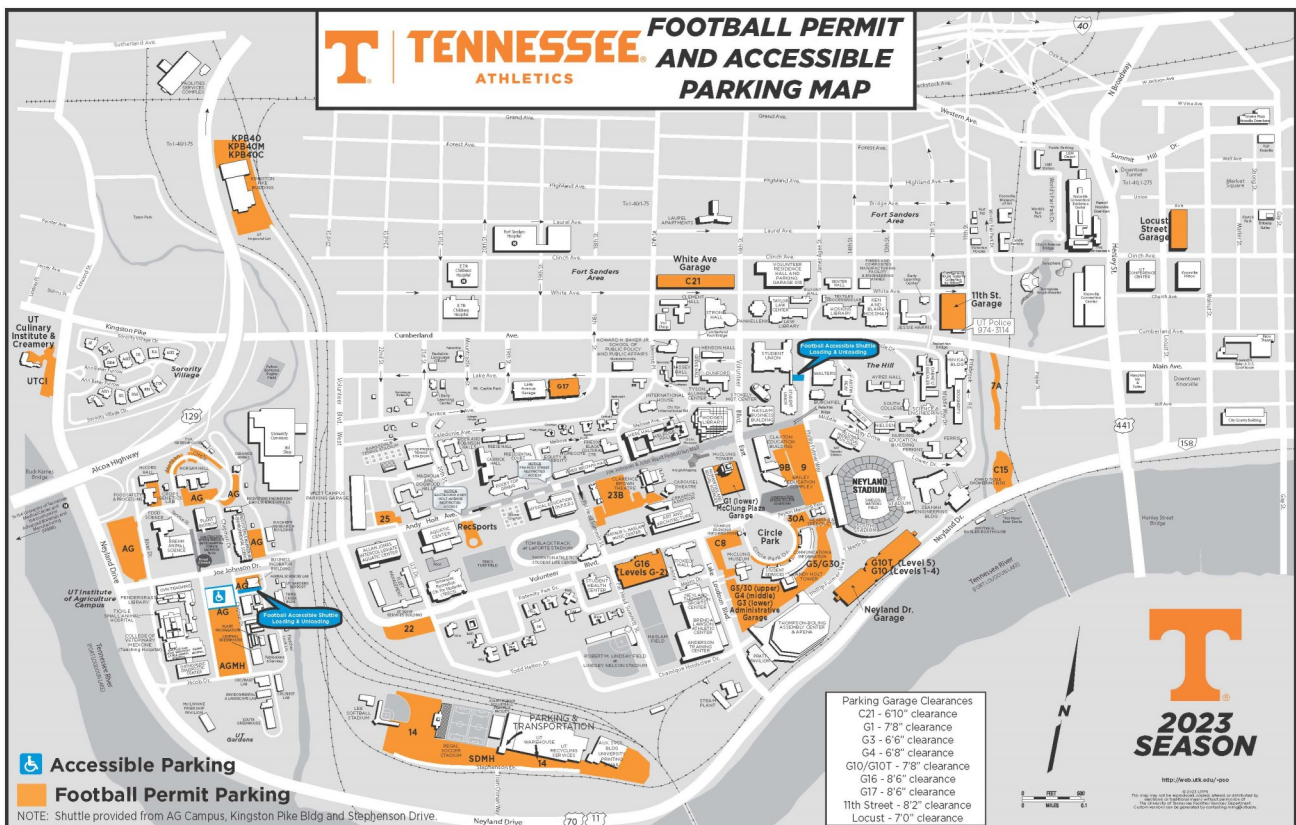
\$25 - City of Knoxville Gameday Parking at meters next to campus on White Ave, Lake Ave, 13th, 16th, 18th, & 19th sts.
Payable ONLY with Credit Card.

Commuter/Grad Student Parking on Home Football Games

There is NO campus parking for commuter students - undergraduate or graduate, on home football game days.

Alternatives for getting to campus include:

1. Have someone drop you off and pick you up
2. East TN Children's Hospital sells gameday parking as a fundraiser for Volunteer Services
3. Knoxville Area Transit (KAT) has 5 regular bus routes serving campus \$2.00 all day pass

Pre-Assigned Football Parking Permit Holders

◆ G10 Garage or Ag Campus

Fans But NO Football Parking Permit - General Public ADA (only 150 spaces available)

◆ Ag Campus

UT Accessible Shuttle from the Ag
Campus begins 3 hours prior

Loads at Business Incubator Bldg

Unloads at Student Union
Loading dock - NOT Gate 21

ACCESSIBLE PARKING OPTIONS OFF CAMPUS

Once the 150 UT accessible spaces
on the Ag Campus are full, we send
guests to the Knoxville Civic Coliseum
at 500 Howard Baker Jr Ave.

There is NO charge for accessible
parking at the Civic Coliseum.

Knoxville Area Transit (KAT) Gameday
shuttle from Civic Coliseum will begin
3 hours prior to kick-off and the shuttle
fee is \$10 round-trip

NEW MAP FOR STUDENT ARRIVAL GATE



Walking path to stadium for student entrance

Lake Loudoun Blvd to Phillip Fulmer Way

Phillip Fulmer at Lake Loudoun will be **CLOSED** starting 3 hours prior to kick-off to provide a safe space to students to enter

Gate 10 & Students enter at the same point

Security screening for both will happen before they are separated

Students will enter stadium on Concourse 1 at sections I & G (old Gate 6 and Gate 5 ramps)
