Special Event parking on campus


Selected parking areas convert from daytime parking to special event parking (specifically near Thompson-Boling Arena)

- \$20 Special Event parking fee (cash or credit card) begins when the lots open for event parking



Which Tickets Can This Apply To?

Donations for Citations has two types of tickets that are eligible:

- No Permit
- Unauthorized Area

How Often Can I Use This?

Once per fiscal year (effective July 1 – June 30) for qualifying tickets that individually amount to a \$32.00 maximum.

Who Can Use This Program?

Eligible participants would be active students, faculty and staff listed in official UT Knoxville records (IRIS & Banner).

What Do I Donate?

You will donate 5 (five) full-sized, non-perishable items such as food or personal care items
